Call for Faculty Fellows, Center for Faculty Excellence

The Center for Faculty Excellence (CFE) requests proposals for year-long Faculty Fellowships (Jan.-Dec. 2024) that build on and enhance CFE's existing programming, resources, and activities to further support OU faculty as they develop their scholarship through research and creative activities, teaching, community engagement, and service.

All OU faculty are eligible to apply. Interested faculty should submit:

- 1. A cover letter (1-2 pages) describing the experience and interests that have prepared them to carry out the proposed work
- 2. A proposal (2 page maximum using the template below) that describes their plan for creating and implementing faculty development programming and other resources that complement or expand on <u>current CFE offerings</u> to support faculty excellence in one or more of the following areas:
 - Discovering, developing, implementing, and sharing innovative and inclusive teaching practices, including game-based learning, and supporting faculty as they transition from practitioners in their field to faculty members.
 - Building infrastructure for faculty mentoring and/or activities that build community among faculty
 - Developing and sharing resources aimed at preparing and supporting faculty leaders
 - Guiding faculty interested in developing Scholarship of Learning projects
 - Supporting faculty efforts in community-engaged research, creative activities, designing service-learning courses and connecting with community partners, nonprofit organizations and other community stakeholders
- 3. C.V., including a list of 3 references who may be contacted regarding the application

Selected faculty fellows will work with current CFE staff and other faculty fellows to develop and implement effective and inclusive faculty development activities and resources from January-December 2024, meeting bi-weekly throughout the academic year and once over the summer. Selected Fellows will receive a 1-course release and \$5000 stipend/discretionary funds.

Application materials should be combined into a single pdf document and emailed to cfe@ou.edu by October 23rd to ensure full consideration.
