

Students (BA, BA/MA, MAIS, GAMA, MAIR) in the College of International Studies (CIS) who wish to participate in-person in the International Studies convocation ceremony are required to register for Convocation by April 1 by submitting an online form through the International Studies website:

http://ou.edu/cis/ias/undergrad-academics/advising/convocation

Note that this is a different link/form than the graduation application. Candidates must complete this registration to be included in the ceremony program and for their guests to be considered in seating.

- > Participating students must arrive at Catlett by 3:10pm on May 14.
- > Candidates must limit their amount of guests attending the ceremony to no more than 10.
- <u>REGALIA:</u> Candidates must wear Academic Regalia, which can be purchased through Graduation Gear-Up in March or ordered online; check this website for updates: <u>https://www.ou.edu/commencement/graduates</u>
- The IAS Bachelor's tassel is white (same as some A&S degrees), and the Master's tassel is black.
- Master's Students, please purchase and bring your master's hood.
- > You are welcome to decorate your mortarboard cap, tasteful and family friendly, please!
- ACCOMMODATIONS: For disability accessible accommodations or seating for candidates or guests, please contact Tracy by April 15.
- The University-wide Commencement ceremony is a separate ceremony from Convocation, and is held on Friday evening, May 13. All graduating students may participate in Commencement: <u>http://www.ou.edu/commencement</u>.
- If Guests are unable to come to graduation, they can watch the ceremony livestream (link will be sent and posted closer to the ceremony).
- MAIR students may choose to participate in this CIS ceremony or the PACS ceremony and should register appropriately.
- Participating students should watch their OU email for additional updated ceremony information from Tracy. Several emails will be sent to those students who have registered through the above link by April 1.
- There will be a CIS pre-graduation reception on Friday afternoon, May 13. Details will be sent to students who register for CIS convocation.
- The Records Office will mail diplomas to spring candidates who have cleared for graduation approximately twelve weeks after the ceremonies. Transcripts with the degree posted will be available around June 1 through the Records Office.
