CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 930117 SENATE BILL NO. GS15-23

#### AS INTRODUCED

An act amending Title XII of the SGACA, providing for a short title; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION

**Section 1:** This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Secretary Compensation Act."

Section 2: The purpose of this act is to increase Secretary pay rates in both Congress and the Graduate Student Senate by the equivalent of 2 hours per week.

**Section 3:** AMENDATORY. The following parts are to be amended to Title XII Chapter 5 of the SGACA:

#### 31. Positions Receiving a Salary/Stipend

Section 1: The following positions shall receive a stipend:

Campus Activities Council Chair: \$365/month

Chair of Congress: \$365/month
Chair of Senate: \$365/month

Chair of SGA Budgetary Committee: \$265/month
Secretary of Congress: \$215/month \$265/month
Secretary of Senate: \$215/month \$265/month

Student Bar Association President: \$290/month

SGA President: \$450/month
SGA Vice President: \$365/month
Vice Chair of Congress: \$265/month
Vice Chair of Senate: \$265/month

Section 4:

All salaried and stipend positions listed within this section, Section 32, shall be compensated monthly with compensation periods beginning September 1st and perpetuating monthly until April 30th of the same academic year except for the positions of SGA President, SGA Vice President, Chair of Congress, Chair of Senate, Campus Activities Council Chair, and Housing Center Student Association President, which shall terminate employment and compensation

May 31st of the same academic year. The SGA President shall be eligible to receive compensation at the aforementioned rate during the summer, which shall consist of the months June, July, and August. The SGA President shall only be eligible to receive such compensation while executing his/her presidential duties in the course of fulfilling his/her office hours.

#### GRADUATE STUDENT SENATE SENATE SESSION GS-15 April 26, 2015

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 930123 SENATE BILL NO. GS15-36

#### AS INTRODUCED

A Congressional Act reorganizing the Sooner Freshman Council, providing for a short title, providing for codification, and providing an effective date.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Freshman Council Act of 2015"
- **Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to amend the Code Annotated to reorganize and remodel the Sooner Freshman Council.
- Section 3: The Code Annotated Title XIII shall be deleted and The Code Annotated Title III Chapter 12 shall be inserted following Title III Chapter 11 to read as follows:

#### <u>Title III – The Executive</u> <u>Chapter 12 – Sooner Freshman Council</u>

#### 1. <u>Delegation Purpose</u>

The SGA Sooner Freshman Council "SFC" shall prepare its members for future involvement within the various branches of the SGA. The SFC will also promote the programs and positions of, raise awareness and understanding of, and advocate for first year student involvement within the SGA as a whole.

#### 2. Membership Requirements and Responsibilities

Full time, first year students in good academic standing with the University shall be eligible to submit applications for membership. These applications shall be reviewed and interviews shall be held by the

Co-Chairs leaving member acceptance and the application process at the Co-Chair's discretion. Members must remain in good academic standing with the University.

#### a Housing Center Student Association Delegate

Every member must serve as a delegate to the HCSA for at least one HCSA general meeting. They will serve as representatives of their housing center as well as speaking to the body about a topic relating to the SGA or governmental interaction as determined by the Co-Chairs pending the HCSA president's approval.

#### 3. Officers

There shall be two Co-Chairs of the council charged with overseeing the delegation.

#### a Eligibility

Sooner Freshman Council members from the previous year, who have remained in good academic standing with the university, are eligible for nomination to a Co-Chair position.

#### **b** Selection

The Co-Chair positions shall be appointed by a board comprised of the SGA President, SGA Vice President, and previous year's Co-Chairs, with advice and consent of the Legislative Branch.

#### C Term Length and Limit

Co-Chairs are appointed for one academic year beginning with their legislative confirmation. Officers may serve no more than one academic year. Officers appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve to the end of the academic year in which they were confirmed by the legislature.

#### d Responsibilities

- The Co-Chairs will work closely with the Departments of the Executive Branch as well as the Legislative and Programming Branches and the HCSA, as necessary, to ensure the purpose of the SFC is carried out.
- It is the responsibility of the Co-Chairs to appoint delegates to the HCSA ensuring that every HCSA general meeting has at least one SFC member present.
- iii Co-Chairs will share all responsibilities and must report to each other.

#### e Vacancies

In the event of a vacancy the responsibilities of the vacated seat shall fall upon the remaining officer, with support of the SGA Vice President, until a suitable replacement has been appointed and confirmed by the legislature. In the event of both positions being vacated the SGA Vice President will serve as sole Chair of the delegation until suitable replacements have been appointed and confirmed by the legislature.

#### f Officer Removal

The SGA Vice President shall have the authority to remove Co-Chairs with 2/3 approval with the advice and consent of the legislature.

#### 4. Internal Proceedings

The SGA Sooner Freshman Council shall establish rules of procedure for the internal operations for the organization. These rules shall be published and available to students upon request. Any

proposed and adopted rule changes must be sent to the SGA Vice President and appropriately distributed.

#### 5. Meetings

Co-Chairs shall establish meeting times for the full academic year by the third academic week of the fall semester. The meetings shall be open to the public and are subject to the Oklahoma Open Meetings Act.

#### 6. Power and Authority

The SFC shall be empowered to create any such committees, boards, commissions, or other such entities that it deems are necessary in order to further its purpose.

#### 7. Funding

The SGA Sooner Freshman Council shall be provided financial support through the Executive Branch.

#### 8. Student Advisement

The student advisor to the SFC shall be the SGA Vice President.

#### 9. Report

At least one of the Co-Chairs shall present a report of the SFC's progress and goals to a minimum of one meeting of the Undergraduate Student Congress per month.
