CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION CR-113-03  
SENATE RESOLUTION NO. GS25-09

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution supporting and empowering victims of sexual assault and providing for distribution.

- Whereas: Two and a half million college students are the victim of sexual assault each year<sup>1</sup>; and
- Whereas: Ninety percent of on-campus sexual assaults are committed by serial offenders, those who sexually assault others more than once<sup>1</sup>; and
- Whereas: Serial offenders sexually assault others an average of six times before they graduate<sup>2</sup>; and
- Whereas: Only six percent of sexual assaults that occur on college campuses are reported to the relevant Title IX office or police department<sup>1</sup>; and
- Whereas: Only 0.25 percent of sexual assaults result in an arrest, felony conviction, and incarceration of the perpetrator<sup>2</sup>; and
- Whereas: There were 99 reported incidents of sexual assault on the campus of the University of Oklahoma from 2021-2023<sup>3</sup>; and
- Whereas: Project Callisto is a nonprofit organization focused on supporting survivors of sexual assault on college campuses; and
- Whereas: Project Callisto has an online platform that enables sexual assault survivors to document their experiences confidentially, either to save for future reporting or to submit to authorities when they feel ready; and
- Whereas: Project Callisto uses a matching system to identify serial offenders; and
- Whereas: Project Callisto connects survivors with Legal Options Counselors to guide survivors through the reporting process and facilitate coordinated action; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

**Section 1:** Title: This resolution shall be known and may be cited as the “Project Callisto Awareness Resolution.”

**Section 2:** Upon the authorization of this resolution, the University of Oklahoma Student Government Association officially recognizes Project Callisto’s efforts to support and empower survivors of sexual assault.

**Section 3:** The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association acknowledges the importance of sexual assault resources for survivors.

**Section 4:** The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association recognizes that Project Callisto can significantly reduce barriers to reporting sexual assault and seeking assistance for survivors.
