- [a] To receive OU credit for METR 1014, the student must take both METR 1123 and METR 1121 at Rose State College.
- [b] These course(s) are in addition to the requirements for the AS degree; however, they will count toward the BS degree at OU.
- [c] The University of Oklahoma Core Area IV: Arts & Humanities specifies students must complete four courses of which an approved Artistic Form (3 hours) and Western Culture (3 hours) is required.
- [d] Students must have 60 hours completed at OU; 40 hours of upper-division coursework; and 30 hours in residence to complete the BS degree.
- [e] First Year Experience (Core V) is waived for students who earn the AS degree, requiring a student to take 3 hours of Free Electives.
- [f] Equivalent courses exist at RSC that will count toward the BS degree at OU.
- [g] Per OU requirements, at least one course used to satisfy the general education requirements must be at the upper division level and outside of the student's major.

Before transferring to OU, have the RSC Registrar send an official transcript to the OU Admissions Office with any degrees earned noted on the transcript. If you have not completed the requirements for an Associate's degree, talk with your OU Academic Advisor about Reverse Transfer options to use OU coursework to complete your RSC Associate's degree.
